Support for travel costs and fieldwork expenses for students of Forestry and Arboriculture Masters Programmes in the UK

Guidance notes:

The following criteria will apply:

- 1. The Masters courses must be carried out in a UK institution and the travel and fieldwork costs must relate to UK costs only.
- 2. The Masters courses must relate to UK forestry or arboriculture.
- 3. Applicants <u>must</u> be selected and recommended by the Programme supervisor from the UK institution.
- 4. No more than two students per Programme (not per module) are eligible for assistance in any one academic year.
- 5. Assistance of up to £300 or 50% of total cost (whichever is least) per student is available, and must be agreed in advance of the travel.
- 6. Payment will be made in arrears and must be supported by receipts or other evidence of expenditure, and accompanied by a description (max 150 words) explaining benefits of the travel and/or a captioned photo showing the fieldwork or study site.
