

Support for travel costs and fieldwork expenses for students of Forestry and Arboriculture Masters Programmes in the UK

Guidance notes:

The following criteria will apply:

1. The Masters courses must be carried out in a UK institution and the travel and fieldwork costs must relate to UK costs only.
2. The Masters courses must relate to UK forestry or arboriculture.
3. Applicants must be selected and recommended by the Programme supervisor from the UK institution.
4. No more than two students per Programme (not per module) are eligible for assistance in any one academic year.
5. Assistance of up to £300 or 50% of total cost (whichever is least) per student is available, and must be agreed in advance of the travel.
6. Payment will be made in arrears and must be supported by receipts or other evidence of expenditure, and accompanied by a description (max 150 words) explaining benefits of the travel and/or a captioned photo showing the fieldwork or study site.
