We ask all successful applicants to acknowledge the Trust's support in any publicity, promotional materials or publications associated with project funded by the Trust.

- Papers, books and other publications
- Exhibitions or conferences
- Flyers, posters or brochures.

Wording your acknowledgement

Successful applicants can use their own words to acknowledge our support, but please make sure to:

- use our full, official name: 'The Scottish Forestry Trust'; and
- refer to the type of assistance you have received from the Trust.

Guidance on media releases

- All media releases about the research we fund should include our logo, and a written acknowledgement of our support
- In acknowledging our support, please make sure that your wording does not imply that
 the research was commissioned by the Trust, is being conducted by the Trust, or is being
 carried out on the Trust's behalf
